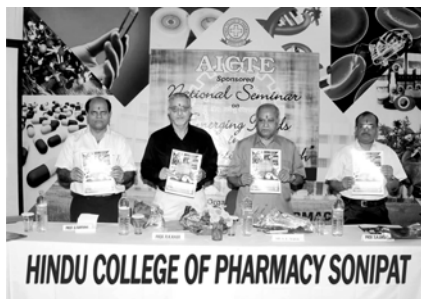


SEMINARS ORGANIZED

National Level Workshop on "Tools for the Design and Synthesis of Drugs"

Department of Pharmaceutical Chemistry organized a national level workshop on "Tools for the Design and Synthesis of Drugs" from 22nd April 2010 to 24th April 2010 (03 days). The national level workshop was given financial support by AICTE, New Delhi. The workshop included seven guest lectures from eminent scientists



from academia, national research institutes and industries. Guest speakers explained the fundamentals of molecular modeling, methodologies of virtual screening; targeting active sites of proteins; while some of the guest speakers also cautioned about the problems which may come during the chemical synthesis (industrial scale) of molecularly designed ligands as they may be complex in structure having chiral centers. In brief the guest speakers summarized the role of molecular modeling including the synthesis of ligands discovered through virtual screening. The workshop also included two days Hands-on experience on drug design software package having experiments on ligand preparation, protein preparation, docking, scoring and QSAR. 60

participants (faculty, PG students, and research scientists from pharmaceutical chemistry background) from 12 organizations (academics and industries) have attended this workshop. Principal Dr. C.V.S. Subrahmanyam was the chairman and Dr. N.M. Raghavendra was the convener of the workshop.
